## Special Programming

**We have opportunities for all ages! Please note programming tailored to your family's needs.**

**Please remember:** Registration implies compliance with camp policies. One camp policy is an agreement to attend all sessions, unless illness interferes. All children and youth are expected to attend their own age group or be with a parent or guardian.

### YOUTH:

**Grades 7-12** have special sessions all week. There will be special study times, small groups, and evening activities. They will also hear the missionaries and Bible Lecturer. Youth Programs begin Monday morning.

### CHILDREN:

Programs for **grades 1-6** are held in Beulah Chapel 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. *Children will see and hear all the missionaries.* A sheet of instructions for parents detailing the children's activities is at the Registration Booth. Children’s programming begins Monday morning.

### PRESCHOOL:

Special sessions for children ages 2-3 and ages 4-5 have been designed on their level in Patience Hall. Sessions begin Sunday night.

### NURSERY: (Ages 0-1)

Care is provided in Patience Hall for all adult sessions except Bonfire and optional afternoon activities. **Parents of infants and toddlers are expected to volunteer to help for a session during the week.** We want to adequately staff each session. Sign-up is in the lower level of Patience Hall.

### MEAL TIMES:

The first meal served is dinner, **Sunday, August 2**. The last meal served is dinner **Friday, August 7**. Meals are available in the Bixler Dining Room. See posted menus and prices.

**CAMPING:** Please, camp only in areas established by the camp. You may camp and do your own cooking. Check with the Registration Booth if there are any questions.

**PETS:** No pets are allowed on the campgrounds. Convenient kennels are located within a few miles of the camp. Inquire through the camp office.

**LAKE ACTIVITIES:** An adult must accompany Children swimming in the lake. The camp has no lifeguard on duty at the lake. Paddleboats, slide and swimming area are supervised. Please obey the rules and be safe at all times.

**OCEAN:** The Ocean is very DANGEROUS! Before going into the ocean, read the brochure on beach safety provided by the camp. **It is imperative that children NOT be on the beach without adult supervision.**
