The new Missions Building is rapidly taking shape. The folks arriving for the summer camps and conferences are getting firsthand looks at how this project is shaping up. There is great enthusiasm for how this building will come to serve the needs of the Camp and enhance its ministry.

We are mostly finished with our dependence on outside contractors for construction timing. The shell is completed and now we are turning our attention to the content. Our goal this summer is to have the Great Room outfitted with sprinklers, electricity, and heating system by August. The sprinkler system is largely installed. The heating system is scheduled to go in by the end of June. Bringing in electricity and framing the walls will likely take us into the start of August.

A number of volunteers and work parties from churches have helped keep the project moving forward. We have also been aided by a number of individuals and churches who have given \$349,000 toward this effort. To get to this point the money that was given has been augmented by drawing on a loan from a local bank. The Camp still does need your generous support to see this project through to completion. **Dr. Mark Scott** as Bible Lecturer. Dr. Scott presently serves as Academic Dean at Ozark Christian College in Joplin, Missouri and has taught New Testament and Preaching at OCC since 1983.

**Florence Muindi, MD**, President, Life In Abundance International. Dr. Muindi has served as a medical missionary since 1989 and has worked extensively throughout Ethiopia, Kenya and Sudan. She is the founder and president of Life in Abundance International, a non-profit religious organization committed to bringing health to the poor through the local church. Dr. Florence Muindi was born in Kenya, Africa and graduated from the University Of Nairobi Medical School in 1989. She holds an M.D. as well as a M.P.H degree. She received training in Switzerland and Belgium in specialized public health interventions, holds a diploma in Urban Poor Theology and is also an ordained minister. She will be accompanied by J.J. Peterson, Pastor of Communication with LIA International.



**Loren Deckard** serves as Director of Development for Polish Christian Ministries (PCM). For 55 years PCM has worked to establish New Testament churches in Poland.

**Doug Reed** is Director of Development for Literature and Teaching Ministries (LATM) LATM is a non-profit organization created to help provide culturally relevant, Christ-centered books in the heart languages of people throughout the world. Doug and Carol Reed have been serving as missionaries in the Dominican Republic for the past 19 years. They are finishing strong—leaving the churches there with faithful Dominican leaders. From a ministry focused on one specific area, they are now transitioning to a work that has a world-wide impact. Doug, pictured here with his wife Carol, is excited about the opportunities to serve with LATM.



**Erin and Brendan Connally** will be working toward the goal of church planting in the Apurimac region of Peru. However, God has gifted them each with unique skills. Erin will be offering dental care in Abancay and the remote outlying regions. There is an existing medical ministry that she will be partnering with that uses a mobile clinic to reach areas with little or no medical care. She will be responding to an important physical need: the lack of dental care in the remote regions of the Andes. She will also be responding to patients spiritual needs by sharing the gospel with patients who may have never heard it and inviting them to come to local church plants partnered with Serving In Mission (SIM USA).

Brendan is in his third year of teaching as the Spanish and Latin teacher at Covenant High School in Tacoma, Washington. Brendan will be teaching English classes and possibly Spanish literacy classes. Peruvians are wanting to learn English more and more as both an economic tool and as a way to function in an increasingly international world. Spanish literacy classes would meet the needs of the many people in Abancay and the surrounding areas who are illiterate and would like to read books, material for jobs, or most importantly God's word.
