Housing and Camping Options at Wi-Ne-Ma Christian Camp

Wi-Ne-Ma Christian Camp now has three houses available to rent. During the weekend there is a two night minimum. They each have a kitchen equipped with a refrigerator, stove, microwave, and coffee maker along

with dishware and cookware. You would need to bring food, bedding, towels and personal items. Also RV and tent camping is available. No pets are allowed and there is a no smoking and no drinking policy.



Parrish Place is a one bedroom, one bath cabin. It has a king size bed and a fold out couch and a gorgeous view of the ocean and campgrounds. It is located by the crosses.



The Bailey house is now available to rent. It is a two bedroom, two bath cabin. There is a queen size bed in one bedroom and a double bed in the other. It has a beautiful ocean view and a view of Winema Lake.



Hutchins House is a three bedroom, three bath house which can serve as a retreat center for up to 10 people. The main floor bedroom has a queen size bed and a set of bunk beds. Downstairs bedroom #1 has a queen size bed and room #2 has a queen size bed and set of bunk beds.

RV & Tent Camping Also Available



RV and Tent Camping is open to the public except during the Adult and Family Conferences. Camping is limited to the RV area at the north end of Camp. Special restrictions are designed to prevent contact with the youth camp or group that is using the Camp facilities.
