

2024 Wi-Ne-Ma Christian Camp RV & Tent Guidelines

Check-In Time: 2:00pm

Check Out Time: 12:00pm (Noon)

- ** **NO PETS ALLOWED** (see PETS below for the narrow exception)
- ** An RV (camping unit) is considered a “trailer, motor home, camper, pickup with canopy, tent trailer or van”
- ** Extra vehicles are required to park in a separate area away from the trailer site
- ** One satellite tent per site

RESERVATIONS:

- Reservations are made online and are required to secure an RV (camping unit) site.
- Drop-in, day-use camping is not available.
- ** **Water is shut off Nov 10, 2024 – Feb 16, 2025.** This helps us preserve our system from rupture during inclement winter months. Electrical remains usable and we have dump station for use before your departure. *Thank you for your understanding.*

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATIONS:

- **A non-refundable one night deposit (+ \$3.50 handling fee), is automatically calculated when making a reservation.** A confirmation email provides a web link to pay the balance of the reservation.
- The guest in whose name a reservation is made (**including any multi-site reservations**) is **RESPONSIBLE TO PAY FOR ALL THE SITES THEY RESERVE.**
- Cancellations 72 hours or more prior to the beginning of a guest’s scheduled arrival will be charged ONLY the first night’s stay and handling fee. **Cancellations less than 72 hour prior to a guest’s scheduled arrival will be charged for the full reservation** except in the case of an emergency and **at the discretion** of the camp Executive Director.

CAMPING SPACES & ETIQUETTE:

- ***Be good neighbors*** by keeping the campsite neat, clean, and orderly. When checking out, leave the camp site clean for the next patron.
- In Spaces 1-11, an RV should occupy the “A” side of the pedestal . . . in Spaces 12-16, an RV should occupy the “B” side
- **An RV should park approx 5 feet off the pedestal** (this includes any slide outs). **Plan to have sufficient lengths of water hoses, electrical cords and sewer hoses to reach the pedestal.**
- **ONLY one RV, one operational tow vehicle and one satellite tent are allowed per RV space.**
- An operational tow vehicle is either a vehicle being towed by an RV or the vehicle towing the RV.
- **Vehicles other than the operational tow vehicle are considered extra vehicles and must pay the extra vehicle fee** (see table above). *At the discretion of the Camp Host or Camp Office, patron will be directed to park their tow vehicle or extra vehicles at an alternate location.*
- **There is an additional fee for extra vehicles and day-visiting guests.** (see table above)

FACILITY USE:

- RV and tent guests may use the **restrooms** on the **north side bottom of Patience Hall** (Bldg #2) . . . Door code will be given in the pre-stay e-mail.
- **RV guests MUST NOT go south of PATIENCE HALL where the RV bathrooms are located.**
- *Visitor passes are required for anyone to interact with a Camp in session & must be secured at the Camp office* [Bldg #1/ Missions Building]. This is equally true of guests wanting to see the Camp outside the June – September camping season.
- RV and tent guests must access the beach at the north RV end of camp. Do not walk south through the camp or use any camp facilities for your own leisure.

PETS:

- **Pets and Emotional Support Animals are not allowed on camp property.** *Please find off-site accommodation prior to arrival.*
- **Service animals** are allowed as they provide an essential service to the owner. **Please contact the Camp Office 72 hours prior to arrival** by email (winema@winema.org) to address these questions: *What are the visually distinct characteristics of the service animal (for identification)? and What task or service has this animal been trained to do?*
- **A guest will be asked to remove an animal from camp property if the animal is not in keeping with its service mandate.** Equally, handlers who have lost control of their Service Animal will, typically, be directed to remove their animal from camp property.

LAKE USE

- **The lake is unavailable June-September while it is being used by our camps.** *Check at the camp office for availability outside those months.*

FIRES:

- **Use only designated fire pits.** Do not make your own campfire area. **Campfires are not allowed in the Patience Hall (east) row** (sites 12 - 16).
- **When building fires on the beach** – stay out of the dune grass and driftwood which are quite flammable. [<https://www.tillamookfiredistrict.com/>]
- **Do not leave fires unattended.** Firewood may be available; inquire with the Camp Host or Office. Please know that much of this is donated and/or cut, split, and stacked through the efforts of

volunteers. Please consider a donation to Wi-Ne-Ma Christian Camp as a way of appreciating these volunteers.

QUIET HOURS:

- Observe quiet hours from **9 pm to 8 am**. If directed by the camp host or Executive Director to be more quiet, please willingly comply. Guests who do not comply with this guideline will be directed to leave the premises and not return.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Personal transport devices (skateboards, bicycles, roller blades) can only be used north of the RV bathrooms and only during Jan – May and Sep - Dec.
- *No substances—including alcohol, marijuana, illegal drugs, tobacco products, vaping—or firearms are allowed in Camp.* Guests who do not observe this guideline will be directed to leave the premises.

OCEAN:

- A guest's time on the beach will be most enjoyable if they watch the tides and use the beach safely. *Don't let the ocean sneak up on you.*

CAMPER STAY LIMITS:

- A guest's maximum stay cannot exceed 21 consecutive days. A reprieve of 7 nights is expected between stays.
- **No public RV/tent use June 20 - Sep 17**
- Public camping dates for 2024 are: **Jan 3—June 19 and Sept 18—Dec 31.**
- Check-In time is 2:00 pm. Check out is Noon.
- For the sake of the camp, the Executive Director may apply additional restrictions or exceptions

COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS:
