Covid-19 Guest Group – Guidelines

Thank you for choosing Wi-Ne-Ma Christian Camp for your retreat. The shadow of Covid-19 and Coronavirus infection has disrupted all our lives including the life and ministry of Wi-Ne-Ma Christian Cap. These guidelines come as a reminder that we still may be exposed as people come together. Christian camping is about sharing life together and “in humility valuing others above yourselves” (Philippians 2:3). We all need to work together to lessen the risk to others and enjoy a self and healthy time here at Wi-Ne-Ma Christian Camp

These guidelines are for all of us whether at Camp or at home.

1. Stay home when sick and especially if you have experienced Covid-19 symptoms in the past week or have tested positive for Covid-19.
2. Wear a mask when indoors and outdoors if 6 foot physical distancing cannot be maintained.
3. Indoors (during meetings, social times, other gathering times): Keep at least 6 feet away from others outside your household.
4. Wash your hands frequently.
5. Practice good respiratory hygiene.
6. Limit gatherings to small groups
